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17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
18	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 14-112.1 of Title 70, unless
20	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
21	A. The State Auditor and Inspector shall perform an
22	independent, comprehensive performance audit on the Oklahoma
23	Department of Career and Technology Education during the fiscal year
24	beginning July 1, 2017.

B. The State Auditor and Inspector shall have the power to take
 custody of any records necessary to the performance of the audit but
 shall minimize actual physical removal of or denial of access to
 such records.

5 C. At the conclusion of the audit, the State Auditor and Inspector shall meet with the director of the Oklahoma Department of 6 7 Career and Technology Education and the State Board of Career and Technology Education to review the audit report to be issued. 8 The 9 report, when issued, shall include any responses to the audit which 10 the director of the Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education or the State Board of Career and Technology Education 11 12 wishes to have included.

D. The State Auditor and Inspector shall file the report with the Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives. The State Board of Career and Technology Education shall post the completed report to its website.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.
SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
