9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

10 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 537.4 of Title 37, unless there
12 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 A. As used in this section, "powdered alcohol" means alcohol
14 prepared or sold in a powder form for either direct use or
15 reconstitution.

16 B. It is unlawful for any person or licensee to use, offer for
17 use, purchase, offer to purchase, sell, offer to sell or possess
18 powdered alcohol.

19 C. It is unlawful for a holder of a license pursuant to the
20 provisions of this chapter for on-premises or off-premises
21 consumption of alcoholic liquors to use powdered alcohol as an
22 alcoholic beverage.

23 D. Any person or license holder that violates this section is
24 guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished as follows:

1 1. For a first offense, by a fine of not more than Three
2 Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) or by imprisonment for not more than
3 thirty (30) days or by both;

4 2. For a second offense, by a fine of not more than Seven
5 Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$750.00) or by imprisonment for not more than
6 six (6) months or by both; or

7 3. For a third or subsequent offense, by a fine of not more
8 than Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) or by imprisonment for not
9 more than two (2) years or by both.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
