12 ~~BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:~~

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 537.4 of Title 37, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. As used in this section, "powdered alcohol" means alcohol
17 prepared or sold in a powder form for either direct use or
18 reconstitution.

19 B. It is unlawful for any person or licensee to use, offer for
20 use, purchase, offer to purchase, sell, offer to sell or possess
21 powdered alcohol.

22 C. It is unlawful for a holder of a license pursuant to the
23 provisions of this chapter for on-premises or off-premises

1 consumption of alcoholic liquors to use powdered alcohol as an
2 alcoholic beverage.

3 D. Any person or license holder that violates this section is
4 guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished as follows:

5 1. For a first offense, by a fine of not more than Three
6 Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) or by imprisonment for not more than
7 thirty (30) days or by both;

8 2. For a second offense, by a fine of not more than Seven
9 Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$750.00) or by imprisonment for not more than
10 six (6) months or by both; or

11 3. For a third or subsequent offense, by a fine of not more
12 than Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) or by imprisonment for not
13 more than two (2) years or by both.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
