6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Office of Disability Concerns;
8 amending 74 O.S. 2011, Section 9.22, which relates to
9 powers and duties; specifying certain forms of
10 community outreach; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 9.22, is
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 9.22. The Office of Disability Concerns shall have the
15 following powers and duties:

16 1. To identify the needs of people with disabilities on a
17 continuing basis and to attempt to meet those needs;

18 2. To serve as a referral and information source for people
19 with disabilities seeking services and for agencies seeking
20 assistance in their provision of services;

21 3. To generate community awareness and support of programs for
22 people with disabilities, with particular emphasis on social media
23 outreach, electronic mail and other forms of digital communication;

1 4. To advise and assist the Governor and the Legislature in
2 developing policies to meet the needs of people with disabilities;
3 and

4 5. To assist agencies in meeting the requirements of Public Law
5 93-112, and subsequent amendments thereto, as the same pertain to
6 people with disabilities.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
