The license shall be 22 valid for a one-year term. 23 Renewal of a license shall not prohibit disciplinary В. 24 proceedings for an act committed prior to the renewal.

The Commissioner may adopt a system under which licenses expire on various dates throughout the year. For any change in such expiration dates, license fees shall be prorated on an appropriate periodic basis.

D. Upon receiving proper application for a trainee license, payment of the proper license fee, and documentation required by the Alarm, Locksmith and Fire Sprinkler Industry Committee, whether such application is submitted in person, by mail or in an electronic format, the Commissioner of Labor shall issue a temporary trainee license to the applicant pending approval or denial of full licensure. The temporary trainee license shall be valid for ninety (90) days and such term may be extended for good cause not to exceed an additional ninety-day period. The person issued a temporary trainee license is required to work under the direct supervision of a licensed person or company. The temporary trainee license shall not be transferrable and shall be surrendered within ten (10) days to the Department of Labor upon issuance of a full license or notice of a denial of licensure.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
