10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 1800.9, as
12 last amended by Section 5, Chapter 22, O.S.L. 2013 (59 O.S. Supp.
13 2018, Section 1800.9), is amended to read as follows:

14 Section 1800.9. A. Upon receiving proper application, payment
15 of the proper license fee, and certification of recommendation by
16 the Alarm and Locksmith Industry Committee, the Commissioner of
17 Labor shall issue a license to the applicant. The license shall be
18 valid for a one-year term.

19 B. Renewal of a license shall not prohibit disciplinary
20 proceedings for an act committed prior to the renewal.

21 C. The Commissioner may adopt a system under which licenses
22 expire on various dates throughout the year. For any change in such
23 expiration dates, license fees shall be prorated on an appropriate
24 periodic basis.

1 D. Upon receiving proper application for a trainee license,
2 payment of the proper license fee, and documentation required by the
3 Alarm, Locksmith and Fire Sprinkler Industry Committee, whether such
4 application is submitted in person, by mail or in an electronic
5 format, the Commissioner of Labor shall issue a temporary trainee
6 license to the applicant pending approval or denial of full
7 licensure. The temporary trainee license shall be valid for ninety
8 (90) days and such term may be extended for good cause not to exceed
9 an additional ninety-day period. The person issued a temporary
10 trainee license is required to work under the direct supervision of
11 a licensed person or company. The temporary trainee license shall
12 not be transferrable and shall be surrendered within ten (10) days
13 to the Department of Labor upon issuance of a full license or notice
14 of a denial of licensure.

15 ~~SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.~~

16 ~~SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation~~
17 ~~of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby~~
18 ~~declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and~~
19 ~~be in full force from and after its passage and approval.~~
