12	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 420.1 of Title 63, unless there
14	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
15	A physician who recommends use of medical marijuana shall not:
16	1. Accept, solicit or offer any form of pecuniary remuneration
17	from or to a caregiver, dispensary, processor, or commercial grower;
18	2. Offer a discount or any other thing of value to a patient
19	who uses or agrees to use a particular caregiver or dispensary;
20	3. Examine a patient for the purposes of recommending medical
21	marijuana at a location where medical marijuana is dispensed; or
22	4. Hold any economic interest in an enterprise that grows,
23	transports, processes, or dispenses medical marijuana.
