6	AS INTRODUCED
7	An Act relating to motor vehicle license plates; amending 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as last
8	amended by Section 25, Chapter 210, O.S.L. 2016 (47 O.S. Supp. 2016, Section 1135.5), which relates to
9	specialty plates; creating Prisoner of War and Missing in Action plates; providing for design of
10	plates; creating Prisoner of War and Missing in Action License Plate Revolving Fund and providing for
11	deposit of specified funds thereto; providing purpose of, and expenditures from, Prisoner of War and
12	Missing in Action License Plate Revolving Fund; providing for codification; and providing an
13	effective date.
14	
15	
16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as
18	last amended by Section 25, Chapter 210, O.S.L. 2016 (47 O.S. Supp.
19	2016, Section 1135.5), is amended to read as follows:
20	Section 1135.5. A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
21	authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
22	plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide
23	financial assistance as provided by this section.
24	

Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
 registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

6 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax 7 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall 8 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates. 9 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain 10 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor 11 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be 12 issued on a staggered system.

The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a 13 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept 14 applications for special license plates authorized under this 15 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's 16 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount 17 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary 18 information directly into such system and generate a receipt 19 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents 20 21 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for 22 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the 23 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund. 24

1 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates 2 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1, 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of 3 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special 4 5 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration 6 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be 7 removed from the vehicle. 8

9 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004, 10 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax 11 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid 12 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the 13 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall 14 15 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time 16 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly. 17

B. The special license plates provided by this section are asfollows:

University or College Supporter License Plates - such plates
 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
 support to any state-supported or private university or college. As
 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
 apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this title;

1 2. Environmental Awareness License Plates - such plates shall 2 be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax 3 Commission by the Department of Environmental Quality in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any 4 5 person wishing to demonstrate support to implement the statewide general public environmental education program created pursuant to 6 the provisions of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. 7 Such plates shall be designed and issued to any person in any combination 8 9 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for 10 personalized license plates. A dealer's license plate issued pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be designated 11 12 an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of the fee imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by 13 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. As provided in 14 15 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title; 16

3. Firefighter License Plates - such plates shall be designed 17 for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid. 18 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four 19 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a 20 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an 21 2.2 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of 23 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to 24

1 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any 2 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may 3 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon 4 5 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire department by either an identification card or letter from the chief 6 of the fire department. The license plate shall be designed in 7 consultation with the Oklahoma Firefighters Association. 8

9 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
10 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &
11 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighters Museum and
12 the Oklahoma Firefighter Fallen and Living Memorial;

4. Wildlife Conservation License Plates - such plates shall be 13 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax 14 15 Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any 16 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in 17 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in 18 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may 19 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license 20 21 plates.

As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

5. Child Abuse Prevention License Plates - such plates shall be
 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
 Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State
 Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child
 Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
 the prevention of child abuse.

7 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected8 shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

9 6. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License Plates -10 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the United States Olympic Committee. 11 The 12 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized 13 license plates. The plate shall contain the official United States 14 15 Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the United 16 17 States Olympic Committee for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the United States Olympic Committee logo or 18 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not 19 more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate 20 21 issued;

7. Oklahoma History License Plates - such plates shall be
designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in
Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee

collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society
 Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

8. Historic Route 66 License Plates - such plates shall be
designed to honor historic Route 66, also known as the "Mother
Road". As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society Revolving
Fund to be distributed to the Route 66 Museum located in Clinton,
Oklahoma;

9 9. Heart of the Heartland License Plates - such plates shall be
10 designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the victims of
11 the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal
12 Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As provided
13 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
14 in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in
15 Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

Emergency Medical Technician License Plates - such plates 16 10. shall be designed and issued to any person who is an emergency 17 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical 18 technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying 19 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an emergency medical 20 21 technician's license. The license plate shall be designed in 22 consultation with the state association of emergency medical technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee 23 collected shall be apportioned to the Emergency Medical Technician 24

Death Benefit Revolving Fund created in Section 1-2505.2 of Title 63
 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

3 11. Fight Breast Cancer License Plates - such plates shall be 4 designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of 5 breast cancer in this state. As provided in this section, an amount 6 of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Breast Cancer Act 7 Revolving Fund;

12. Crime Victims Awareness License Plates - such plates shall 8 9 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate 10 awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates 11 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims 12 Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for 13 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use 14 15 such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to provide services to crime victims; 16

13. Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License Plates - such plates 17 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate 18 support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. 19 The license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma 20 21 Safe Kids Association. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Children's Hospital -22 Oklahoma Safe Kids Association Revolving Fund to be distributed to 23 the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association program; 24

1 14. Four-H Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed, 2 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the 3 Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed and issued 4 5 to any person as for personalized license plates. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to 6 the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving Fund created in 7 Section 1104.4 of this title; 8

9 15. Agricultural Awareness License Plates - such plates shall 10 be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax 11 Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and 12 Forestry in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag 13 in the Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an 14 15 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.3 of this title; 16

16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plates - such plates 17 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate 18 the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. 19 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma 20 21 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be 22 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial 23

Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of
 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

3 Support Education License Plates - such plates shall be 17. designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission 4 5 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to 6 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license 7 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate 8 9 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as 10 follows: 11

- a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education
 Reform Revolving Fund,
- b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher
 Education Revolving Fund,
- 16 c. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State 17 Career Technology Fund, and
- d. eighty-five percent (85%) of the fee shall be
 deposited to the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund as
 set forth in Section 17-108 of Title 70 of the
 Oklahoma Statutes.

However, when the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund attains a seventy percent (70%) funded ratio based on an annual actuarial valuation as required by law, the amount of the fee shall be

1 apportioned equally pursuant to subparagraphs a, b and c of this
2 paragraph;

3 18. Retired Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers License Plates such plates shall be designed and issued to any retired officer of 4 5 the Oklahoma Highway Patrol. The license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma" and shall contain, in the center of the plate, the 6 Highway Patrol Officers patch using the same colors and pattern as 7 used in the patch. Centered on the bottom of the license plate 8 9 shall be the word "Retired". The letters "TRP" shall be used in 10 combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or 11 emblem. The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown. 12 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to 13 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any 14 deceased retired officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, if the 15 spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is 16 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a Retired 17 Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers license plate. As provided in this 18 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited into the 19 Law Enforcement Retirement Fund; 20

19. Boy Scouts of America Supporter License Plates - such
plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
demonstrate support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall
be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters

1 from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. 2 The plate shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into 3 a licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any 4 5 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts of America logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide 6 for a payment to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty 7 Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued; 8

9 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plates - such 10 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the 11 Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and 12 Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and 13 beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate 14 15 support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5 16 of this title; 17

18 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plates - such plates 19 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax 20 Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and 21 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma 22 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee 23 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation

Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and
 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks;

3 Adoption Creates Families License Plates - such plates 22. shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of 4 5 pregnant women who are committed to placing their children for adoption and wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive 6 parents and other created families to assist in the adoption and 7 placement of children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates 8 9 shall be designed and final terminology delivered in consultation 10 with the Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected shall 11 Services. 12 be deposited in a revolving fund established in the State Treasury for and to be used by the Department of Human Services for the 13 implementation of the Investing in Stronger Oklahoma Families Act 14 15 specifically for created families;

Choose Life License Plates - such plates shall be designed, 16 23. subject to criteria presented to the Tax Commission, by Choose Life, 17 Inc., and issued to any person who wishes to demonstrate support of 18 organizations that encourage adoption as a positive choice for women 19 with unplanned pregnancies. As provided in this section, an amount 20 21 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Choose Life 22 Assistance Program Revolving Fund established in Section 1104.6 of this title; 23

1 24. Future Farmers of America License Plate - such plates shall 2 be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for 3 the Oklahoma FFA (formerly known as Future Farmers of America). The 4 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma 5 FFA Foundation Board of Directors. As provided in this section, an 6 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in 7 Section 1104.7 of this title;

Lions Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed 8 25. 9 and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Lions 10 Club of Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any person in any 11 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, 12 as for personalized license plates. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation 13 and shall contain the official logo of the International Association 14 of Lions Clubs. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter 15 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Lions Service 16 Foundation. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to 17 the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation of not more than Ten Dollars 18 (\$10.00) for each license plate issued; 19

20 26. Color Oklahoma License Plates - such plates shall be
21 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
22 by the Oklahoma Native Plant Society, and issued to any person
23 wishing to demonstrate support for preserving and planting
24 wildflowers and native plants in Oklahoma and to promote Oklahoma's

wildflower heritage through education. As provided in this section,
 an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
 Section 1104.8 of this title;

27. Girl Scouts of the United States of America Supporter 4 5 License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Girl Scouts of the 6 United States of America. The plates shall be issued to any person 7 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of 8 9 seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain 10 the official Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a 11 12 licensing agreement with the Girl Scouts of the United States of America for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use 13 the Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo or design. 14 The 15 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Girl Scouts of Magic Empire Council, acting on behalf of all Oklahoma Girl Scout 16 councils, of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license 17 plate issued; 18

19 28. Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon License Plates - such 20 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to 21 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon. The 22 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma City 23 Memorial Marathon. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter 24 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon

for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

6 29. Oklahoma Scenic Rivers License Plate - such plates shall be 7 designed to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers. The 8 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Scenic 9 Rivers Commission. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee shall be 10 apportioned to the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers Commission;

11 30. Fight Cancer License Plate - such plates shall be designed 12 to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry. The plate shall contain the American Cancer Society logo. 13 The American Cancer Society logo shall be used in accordance with the 14 American Cancer Society's branding guidelines and shall only be 15 utilized to support the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry. Twenty 16 17 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry Revolving Fund; 18

19 31. Animal Friendly License Plate - such plates shall be 20 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for 21 controlling the overpopulation of dogs and cats through educational 22 and sterilization efforts. The plates shall be designed in 23 consultation with the Veterinary Medical Association. Twenty 24 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee collected shall be designated by the

purchaser of the plate to be deposited in the Oklahoma Pet Overpopulation Fund created in Section 2368.13 of Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes or the Animal Friendly Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.10 of this title;

5 32. Patriot License Plate - such plates shall be designed in consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma and issued to 6 any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who 7 are members of the Oklahoma National Guard and deployed on active 8 9 duty. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination 10 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for 11 personalized license plates. As provided in this section, a portion 12 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Patriot License Plate 13 Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.11 of this title;

33. Global War on Terrorism License Plate - such plate shall be 14 15 designed in consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma 16 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma 17 residents who are members of the Armed Forces of the United States or Oklahoma National Guard that have served in the Global War on 18 The plate shall be issued to any person in any 19 Terrorism. combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six. 20 As 21 provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected shall be 22 deposited in the 45th Infantry Division Museum Fund created in Section 235.1 of Title 44 of the Oklahoma Statutes; 23

1 34. Boys and Girls Clubs of America Supporter License Plates -2 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to 3 demonstrate support for the Boys and Girls Clubs of America. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers 4 5 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain the official Boys and Girls 6 Clubs of America logo. The Tax Commission, if necessary, may enter 7 into a licensing agreement with the Boys and Girls Clubs of America 8 9 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the 10 Boys and Girls Clubs of America logo or design. The licensing 11 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Boys and Girls Clubs of America of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license 12 plate issued; 13

14 35. Oklahoma Quarter Horse License Plates - such plates shall 15 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support 16 for the American Quarter Horse in Oklahoma. The plate shall be 17 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Quarter Horse 18 Association. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee 19 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Quarter Horse Revolving 20 Fund created in Section 1104.12 of this title;

36. Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License Plate - such
plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
Association for the Deaf and issued to any person wishing to
demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who are deaf. The plates

March of Dimes License Plate - such plates shall be issued 13 to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the March of Dimes 14 mission to improve the health of babies by preventing birth defects, 15 premature birth and infant mortality. The license plates shall be 16 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter March of Dimes. 17 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be 18 deposited in the Oklahoma Prevent Birth Defects, Premature Birth and 19 Infant Mortality Fund established in Section 1104.14 of this title; 20

39. Support Our Troops Supporter License Plates - such plates
shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
support for Support Our Troops Incorporated. The plates shall be
issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from

The Tax Commission 12 shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the 13 Oklahoma Association of Chiefs of Police for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the association's logo or 14 15 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma Association of Chiefs of Police of not more than Twenty 16 17 Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued. Subject to the provisions of subsection A of this section, the Chiefs of Police 18 License Plate is hereby reauthorized effective November 1, 2015; 19 54. Crossings Christian School License Plate - such plates 20 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate 21 support for Crossings Christian School located in Oklahoma City. 22 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the 23

administration of Crossings Christian School. The Tax Commission

The Tax Commission shall be 12 authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the Hilldale Education Foundation for any licensing fees which may be required in 13 order to use the foundation's logo or design. The licensing 14 15 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Hilldale Education Foundation of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license 16 17 plate issued;

Oklahoma Nurses License Plate - such plates shall be issued 19 to any person licensed pursuant to the Oklahoma Nursing Practice Act 20 and providing such documentation of current licensure as may be 21 required by the Oklahoma Tax Commission. 58. Childhood Cancer Awareness License Plate - such plates 13 shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the 14 Oklahoma Children's Cancer Association. The license plates shall be 15 designed in consultation with the administration of the Oklahoma 16 17 Children's Cancer Association. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma 18 Children's Cancer Association for any licensing fees which may be 19 required in order to use the Oklahoma Children's Cancer 20 21 Association's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide 22 for a payment to the Oklahoma Children's Cancer Association of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued; 23

9 60. Remembering Fallen Heroes License Plate - such plates shall 10 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support 11 for Concerns of Police Survivors, Inc. Such plates shall be 12 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma chapter of Concerns of Police Survivors, Inc. As provided in this section, an amount of 13 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Concerns of 14 15 Police Survivors License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 16 1104.27 of this title; and

61. Prisoner of War and Missing in Action License Plate - such 17 plates shall be issued to any person wishing to increase awareness 18 of those who are currently prisoners of war or missing in action and 19 20 to provide financial support for current veterans and shall be for a vehicle or motorcycle in any combination of numbers and letters from 21 one to seven, as for personalized plates. The license plates shall 22 23 be designed in consultation with Rolling Thunder Oklahoma. The 24 license plate for a motorcycle may be of similar design as space

permits or a new design in order to meet the space requirement of a motorcycle license plate. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Prisoner of War and Missing in Action License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 2 of this act.

C. The fee for such plates shall be Thirty-five Dollars
(\$35.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration fees
provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. The
fee shall be apportioned as follows:

10 1. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) or any other amount as provided in 11 this title of the fee shall be apportioned as provided or deposited 12 in a fund as specified within the paragraph authorizing the special 13 license plate;

20 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1104.28 of Title 47, unless 22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 23 A. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee authorized by Section 24 1135.5 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes for Prisoner of War and

Missing in Action license plates shall be deposited to the Prisoner
 of War and Missing in Action Revolving Fund created in subsection B
 of this section.

There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving 4 Β. 5 fund for the State Military Department to be designated the "Prisoner of War and Missing in Action License Plate Revolving 6 Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal 7 year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the 8 9 Military Department of the State of Oklahoma pursuant to subsection 10 A of this section. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund 11 are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the 12 Military Department for the purpose of assisting Oklahoma veterans 13 in need. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by 14 15 law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise 16 Services for approval and payment.
