10	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 420.1 of Title 63, unless there
12	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
13	A. The State Department of Health shall create a medical
14	marijuana use registry for physicians, patients and caregivers. The
15	handling of any records maintained in this registry shall be
16	compliant with the provisions of the Health Insurance Portability
17	and Accountability Act (HIPAA).
18	B. The medical marijuana use registry shall:
19	1. Be accessible to Oklahoma physicians and medical marijuana
20	dispensaries to verify the authorization of a licensed patient or
21	caregiver to possess medical marijuana or medical marijuana
22	products;

1	2. Be accessible to licensed physicians to ensure proper care
2	for patients before medications are prescribed that may interact
3	with the medical use of marijuana; and
4	3. Prevent an active registration of a patient by multiple
5	physicians.
