13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 322, O.S.L.
15	2013 (63 O.S. Supp. 2016, Section 1-2506.1), is amended to read as
16	follows:
17	Section 1-2506.1. A. First responders shall have the authority
18	to administer, without prescription, opiate antagonists when
19	encountering an individual exhibiting signs of an opiate overdose.
20	For the purposes of this provision, a first responder shall include:
21	1. Law enforcement officials;
22	2. Emergency medical technicians;
23	3. Firefighters; and

1	4. Medical personnel at secondary schools and institutions of
2	higher education; and
3	5. Forensic laboratory personnel of the Oklahoma State Bureau
4	of Investigation as designated by the Executive Director.
5	B. Any first responder administering an opiate antagonist in a
6	manner consistent with addressing opiate overdose shall be covered
7	under the Good Samaritan Act.
8	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
