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An Act relating to opiate antagonists; amending Section 1, Chapter 322, O.S.L. 2013 (63 O.S. Supp. 2016, Section 1-2506.1), which relates to persons authorized to administer; permitting certain employees of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation to administer; and providing an effective date.

SUBJECT: Administering opiate antagonists

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 322, O.S.L. 2013 (63 O.S. Supp. 2016, Section 1-2506.1), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1-2506.1. A. First responders shall have the authority to administer, without prescription, opiate antagonists when encountering an individual exhibiting signs of an opiate overdose. For the purposes of this provision, a first responder shall include:

- 1. Law enforcement officials;
- 2. Emergency medical technicians;
- 3. Firefighters; and

- 4. Medical personnel at secondary schools and institutions of higher education; and
- 5. Forensic laboratory personnel of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation as designated by the Executive Director.
- B. Any first responder administering an opiate antagonist in a manner consistent with addressing opiate overdose shall be covered under the Good Samaritan Act.
  - SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
