11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 20 O.S. 2011, Section 92.6, is
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 92.6. District No. 5. The counties of Comanche,
15 ~~Stephens, and Cotton and Jefferson.~~ Said The district shall have
16 ~~five (5)~~ four (4) district judges to be nominated as follows:
17 Candidates for office Nos. 1 and 4 to be nominated and elected ~~at~~
18 ~~large~~ and legal residents of Comanche or Cotton County; ~~a candidate~~
19 ~~for office No. 2 to be nominated and elected at large and a legal~~
20 ~~resident of Stephens or Jefferson County;~~ and candidates for office
21 Nos. 2 and 3 ~~and 5~~ to be nominated and elected ~~at large~~ and legal
22 residents of Comanche County.

23 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 20 O.S. 2011, Section 92.7, is
24 amended to read as follows:

1 Section 92.7. District No. 6. The counties of Grady, Stephens,
2 Jefferson and Caddo. ~~Said~~ The district shall have ~~one~~ two district
3 ~~judge~~ judges to be nominated ~~and elected at large~~ as follows: A
4 candidate for office No. 1 to be nominated and elected and a legal
5 resident of Grady or Caddo County; and a candidate for office No. 2
6 to be nominated and elected and a legal resident of Stephens or
7 Jefferson County.

8 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
