L 4	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified

L 6	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
L 7	A. Prior to any state election, the Secretary of the State
L8	Election Board shall cause to be prepared a voter information
L 9	pamphlet designed to inform the voters about the candidates and
20	issues that will be on the ballot. Both a printed and an electronic
21	version of the pamphlet shall be prepared.
22	B. The pamphlet shall contain such information as deemed
23	necessary by the Secretary of the State Election Board, including
24	but not limited to, the following:

- 1. The ballot title of any state question submitted to the voters by the Legislature or by a statewide initiative or referendum petition. The electronic version of the pamphlet shall include a link to an electronic version of the complete text of the question;
- 2. A section describing the judicial selection and retention process and listing each judicial candidate for election or retention;
 - 3. A list of all candidates for statewide office;
 - 4. A list of all candidates for legislative office;
 - 5. A list of all candidates for county office;

- 6. A list of all candidates for district attorney;
- 7. The date of the election and hours that the polls will be open on such date;
 - 8. The dates and hours for in-person absentee voting;
 - 9. Information on obtaining and submitting absentee ballots;
- 10. Such other information as deemed necessary and appropriate by the Secretary of the State Election Board.
- C. Each candidate for office may submit a recent photograph and a statement of qualifications to hold the office to the State Election Board before the ninetieth day prior to the day of the election to be included in the pamphlet. Such statement shall not exceed one hundred (100) words in length and shall not contain information about any other candidates for that or any other office.
