SENATE BILL 786 By: Jett

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1540 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

This state declares all public and private business enterprises to be essential businesses for the economic welfare of the state and its political subdivisions. All businesses operating in this state contribute to the support of the citizens of this state and pay income taxes and unemployment contributions that are essential to the welfare of this state and its citizens. Any emergency declaration to close or limit the operations of any business legally operating in this state shall not be enforced. No person or

1	governmental entity, whether state or federal, shall be authorized
2	or empowered to create an economic disadvantage for any business
3	legally operating in this state by declaring a business to be
4	nonessential during a state of emergency.
5	SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation

7	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
