15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 650.4, as
16	amended by Section 2, Chapter 68, O.S.L. 2020 (21 O.S. Supp. 2020,
17	Section 650.4), is amended to read as follows:
18	Section 650.4. A. Every person who, without justifiable or
19	excusable cause and with intent to do bodily harm, commits any
20	assault, battery or assault and battery upon the person of a medical
21	care provider who is performing medical care duties, upon
22	conviction, is guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment in the
23	custody of the Department of Corrections for a term not exceeding
24	

1 two (2) years, or by a fine not exceeding One Thousand Dollars
2 (\$1,000.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment.

B. As used in this section, "medical care provider" means
doctors, residents, interns, nurses, nurses' aides, ambulance
attendants and operators, paramedics, emergency medical technicians,
laboratory technicians, radiologic technologists, physical
therapists, physician assistants, chaplains, volunteers,
pharmacists, nursing students, medical students, respiratory
therapists and members of a hospital security force.

Section 650.5. A. Every person who, without justifiable or 13 excusable cause and with intent to do bodily harm, commits any 14 15 aggravated assault and battery or any assault with a firearm or other deadly weapon upon the person of a medical care provider, upon 16 conviction, is guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment in the 17 custody of the Department of Corrections for a term not less than 18 two (2) years nor more than five (5) years, or by a fine not to 19 exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by both such fine and 20 imprisonment. 21

B. As used in this section, "medical care provider" means
doctors, residents, interns, nurses, nurses' aides, ambulance
attendants and operators, paramedics, emergency medical technicians,
