The President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall make initial appointments for attorney members of the Commission pursuant to subsection A of this section within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this act.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective in accordance with the provisions of Section 58 of Article V of the Oklahoma Constitution.
