6	AS INTRODUCED
7	An Act relating to the Oklahoma Tourism and
8	Recreation Department employees; amending 74 O.S. 2011, Section 2242, which relates to unclassified
9	positions; reclassifying positions on certain date; authorizing continuation of merit positions until
10	certain occurrences; requiring certain notice be given to employee upon reclassification of position;
11	providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 2242, is
16	amended to read as follows:
17	Section 2242. The following offices and positions in the
18	Beginning July 1, 2021, employees of the Oklahoma Tourism and
19	Recreation Department shall be in the unclassified service and shall
20	not be subject to the Merit System of Personnel Administration \div
21	1. The Executive Director, the Deputy Director, directors of
22	the divisions of the Department and administrative assistant of
23	each, and not more than four positions involved in the executive
24	management of the Department;

1	2. All positions in the Traveler Response Information Program;
2	3. All professional or managerial positions whose principal
3	function is one of the following:
4	a. marketing and promotion of travel and tourism to and
5	within the state,
6	b. promoting the state as a viable location for producing
7	motion pictures and television programs and for
8	recording music,
9	c. developing, producing, and on-air broadcasting of
10	"Discover Oklahoma", the weekly promotional television
11	program,
12	d. not more than fifteen positions performing financial
13	management functions for the Department,
14	e. not more than five positions performing human
15	resources functions for the Department, and
16	f. not more than two positions performing information
17	services functions for the Department;
18	4. Any position associated with the development and production
19	of "Oklahoma Today" magazine; and
20	5. Any position in the Division of State Parks utilized in the
21	operation and administration of state resorts, cabins, lodges, and
22	golf courses. An employee of the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation
23	Department who is in the Merit System of Personnel Administration on
24 4	July 1, 2021, may elect to retain their merit classification until

1	such position is vacated, abolished or the employee elects
2	unclassified status. Any position changed from a merit position to
3	unclassified service within the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation
4	Department on or after July 1, 2021, shall require a thirty-day
5	written notice be given to the current employee filling such
6	position.
7	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2021.
8	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
9	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
10	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
11	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
