7 An Act relating to mental health; Section 2, State
8 Question No. 791, Initiative Petition No. 405, as
9 adopted on November 8, 2016, which relates to the
10 County Community Safety Investment Fund; directing
11 submission of certain report; and providing an
12 effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 2, State Question No. 791,
15 Initiative Petition No. 405, as adopted on November 8, 2016, is
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 2. A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a
18 revolving fund to be designated the "County Community Safety
19 Investment Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject
20 to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received
21 pursuant to Section 633 of Title 57 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

22 B. All monies appropriated and accruing to the credit of the
23 fund shall be budgeted and expended by the Office of Management and
24 Enterprise Services for the sole purpose of providing funds to
counties to provide community rehabilitative programming, including

1 but not limited to mental health and substance abuse services.
2 Funds shall be disbursed in proportion to county population, as
3 reported in the most recent census.

4 C. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants
5 issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by
6 law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise
7 Services for approval and payment.

8 D. The Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise
9 Services shall promulgate rules necessary to implement the
10 provisions of ~~this act~~ the Oklahoma Smart Justice Reform Act.

11 E. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall
12 submit an annual report to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate
13 and the Speaker of the House of Representatives detailing the
14 savings and averted costs that accrued to the state from the
15 implementation of the Oklahoma Smart Justice Reform Act.

16 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.

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
