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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
17	codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:
18	This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Expand Medicaid
19	Now Act".
20	SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1010.14 of Title 56, unless
22	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
23	A. The state shall expand the Medicaid program to provide
24	assistance to all persons who apply and who are determined to be

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- eligible for such assistance and for whom federal matching funds are available to the state under the Patient Protection and Affordable

 Care Act, P.L 111-148, as amended by the Health Care and Education

 Reconciliation Act of 2010, P.L. 111-152.
 - B. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority is hereby directed to take any and all steps necessary to implement the Medicaid expansion program as provided for in subsection A and shall be the lead agency for the implementation. The Authority is authorized to seek assistance from any state or federal agencies or entities to implement the program, and all state agencies or entities shall provide such assistance as requested by the Authority.
 - C. The Legislature shall annually appropriate sufficient funding to the Authority for the purpose of implementing and operating the Medicaid expansion program pursuant to this act.
 - D. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority Board shall promulgate rules to implement this act.
 - SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
