9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
10	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 405.5 of Title 10, unless there
12	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
13	All licensed child care facilities shall:
14	1. Follow the Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP)
15	nutrition standards for infants;
16	2. Provide children with opportunities for moderate and
17	vigorous physical activity for at least sixty (60) minutes per day
18	during a full-day program or thirty (30) minutes per day during a
19	half-day program, including daily outdoor physical activity when
20	possible, and by providing infants daily opportunities to freely
21	explore their indoor and outdoor environments under adult
22	supervision, including engaging with infants on the ground each day
23	to optimize adult-infant interactions, and providing daily time in
24	the prone position for infants less than six (6) months of age; and

1	3. Eliminate screen time, including television, movies,
2	cellular phones, video games, computers and other digital devices
3	for children less than two (2) years of age except for special
4	occasions. Such occasions shall be limited to no more than ninety
5	(90) minutes once per week.
6	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
