BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. A new section of law to be codified NEW LAW in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 18-114.15 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

- Beginning with the 2019-2020 school year, a school district board of education shall not enter into a new contract or renew a contract with a superintendent in which the maximum compensation exceeds Seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) per student based on the average daily attendance, as defined by Section 18-107 of Title 70 in the Oklahoma Statutes.
- In no case shall the amount of compensation exceed Seventy-В. five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000.00).

1	C. For the purposes of this section, "compensation" shall mean
2	base salary and fringe benefits.
3	D. The State Board of Education shall promulgate rules
4	necessary to implement the provisions of this act.
5	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.
6	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
8	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
