STATE OF OKLAHOMA Ist Session of the 59th Legislature (2023) SENATE BILL 807 By: Garvin

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to medical marijuana; creating the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Commission; authorizing the Executive Director of the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority to chair; providing for composition of Commission; requiring Commission to prepare certain report; allowing for certain reimbursement; requiring Commission to be subject to Oklahoma Open Meeting Act; requiring the Legislature to provide staffing for Commission; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 427.26 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

- A. There is hereby created the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Commission.
- B. The Commission shall be chaired by the Executive Director of the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority and be composed of thirteen (13) members representing the health community, state and local law enforcement, the medical marijuana business community, and the Legislature. The Commissioner of the Department of Mental Health

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and Substance Abuse Services, or a designee, the Director of the Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control, or a designee, the Chairman of the District Attorneys Council, or a designee, and the Commissioner of the State Department of Health, or a designee, shall serve as members. The first meeting of the Commission shall be called by the Chair.

C. The Commission shall be composed of:

- 1. Two members appointed by the Governor;
- 2. Two members appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives;
- 3. Two members appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate; and
 - 4. Two members appointed by the Attorney General.
- C. The Commission shall study, evaluate, and make recommendations for any changes to state policy, rules, or statutes for the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority.
- D. The Commission shall prepare and issue a report of its findings and recommendations to the Governor, President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives by December 31, 2024, and each year thereafter no later than December 31 of each year.
- E. Members of the Commission shall receive no compensation for serving on the Commission but shall receive travel reimbursement in accordance with the State Travel Reimbursement Act.

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1	F. The meetings of the Commission shall be subject to the
2	Oklahoma Open Meeting Act.
3	G. Staffing for the Commission shall be provided by the Senate
4	and the House of Representatives.
5	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
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
