6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Cosmetology and  
8 Barbering Act; amending 59 O.S. 2011, Section 199.10,  
9 as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 265, O.S.L.  
10 2016 (59 O.S. Supp. 2016, Section 199.10), which  
11 relates to license renewals; permitting certain  
12 continuing education for certain renewals; and  
13 providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 199.10, as  
16 last amended by Section 1, Chapter 265, O.S.L. 2016 (59 O.S. Supp.  
17 2016, Section 199.10), is amended to read as follows:

18 Section 199.10. A. All licenses issued under the provisions of  
19 the Oklahoma Cosmetology and Barbering Act shall be issued for a  
20 period of one (1) year. The expiration date of the license shall be  
21 the last day of the month in which the applicant's birthday falls.  
22 The public display of a licensee's personal residential address on  
23 the face of any license issued pursuant to the provisions of the  
24 Oklahoma Cosmetology and Barbering Act shall be prohibited on and  
after July 1, 2016, and such personal address information, if

1 publically displayed on a valid license, may be redacted by the  
2 licensee until the license is renewed and no longer bears his or her  
3 personal residential address.

4 B. Applications for renewal must be made on or before the last  
5 day of the month in which the applicant's birthday falls, and shall  
6 be accompanied by the appropriate fees.

7 C. Any person who fails to renew the license within the  
8 required time may make application for renewal at any time within  
9 five (5) years from the expiration date of the license by paying the  
10 regular renewal license fee and a late fee of Ten Dollars (\$10.00),  
11 which becomes due two (2) months after the expiration date.

12 D. Any person who fails to renew within the required time may  
13 make application with subsequent renewal and penalty fees.

14 E. Before a person may take an examination to renew an expired  
15 license after a period of five (5) years, such person shall register  
16 in a cosmetology or barber school for the given number of review  
17 hours in accordance with the following timetable and schedule based  
18 upon the type of license held.

13 F. Each person holding a license shall notify the Board of any  
14 change in the mailing address of such person within thirty (30) days  
15 after any change.

16 G. The Board may require one (1) hour of continuing education  
17 relating to domestic violence and sexual assault awareness prior to  
18 the renewal of any license issued pursuant to this section.

19 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
