## STATE OF OKLAHOMA 1st Session of the 58th Legislature (2021) SENATE BILL 82 By: Bullard 4

## AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce; amending 74 O.S. 2011, Section 5003.8, which relates to annual report; directing certain additional report be published annually; naming report the Future of Oklahoma Industry and Labor (FOIL) Report; providing purpose and content of report; mandating interactive map of certain data on websites; directing collaboration and contribution by certain agencies; providing date for reports to be published; updating statutory reference; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 5003.8, is amended to read as follows:

Section 5003.8. A. In order to ensure that the Oklahoma

Department of Commerce is effectively implementing its mission,

purpose and objectives, the Department shall publish an annual

report setting forth in detail the operations and programs conducted

by it pursuant to this act Section 5003.2 et seq. of this title or

to other legislation. The report shall review both statewide

progress and departmental progress according to several measures

including objective measures listed in the Department's five-year plan. The Department shall present this report to the Governor and the Legislature. The annual report shall specifically account for ways in which the needs, mission and programs of the Department described in this act Section 5003.2 et seq. of this title have been carried out and recommendations shall specifically note what changes in the activities of the Department and the programs it administers and of state government are necessary to better address the mission described in this act Section 5003.2 et seq. of this title. The Department shall distribute its annual report by such means that will make it widely available to communities, firms and local economic development managers throughout this state.

B. In addition to subsection A of this section, the Oklahoma
Department of Commerce shall be responsible for collecting data and
publishing on their website an annual report to be called the
"Future of Oklahoma Industry and Labor (FOIL) Report". The report
shall analyze and describe the current and predictable trends of the
jobs, industries and labor workforce in this state. The report
shall include an interactive map covering the various regions of the
state to show trends in specific job markets, growth industries and
labor workforce shortages as analyzed in the published report. The
first report shall be published on July 1, 2022, and a report shall
be due each July 1 thereafter.

- C. In a collaborative effort, the following agencies and entities shall work in conjunction with the Department to assist in the collection and analysis of data and the formulation of each annual FOIL report specified in subsection B of this section. Each shall contribute and analyze data for the Department and shall be required to maintain a link connection to the FOIL report and interactive map on their separate websites:
  - 1. Oklahoma Employment Security Commission;
  - 2. Department of Labor;
  - 3. Department of Career and Technology Education;
  - 4. The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education;
- 5. The Center for Economic Management Research at the University of Oklahoma; and
- 6. The Center for Economic and Business Development at Southwestern Oklahoma State University.
- D. The report shall be utilized by the Department of Education and the Department of Career and Technology Education, and may be utilized by the various public and private secondary and higher education institutions of this state, to identify and prepare specific course content and curriculum which trains students for future occupations, job markets, identified growth industries, labor workforce trends, gaps in skill level and highly marketable professions in this state.
