AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2011, Section 1-1990.2, is 10 amended to read as follows: 11 Section 1-1990.2. As used in the Silver Alert Act: 12 1.3 1. "Alert" means the statewide silver alert for missing senior citizens or distressed individuals; 1 4 2. "Local law enforcement agency" includes, but is not limited 15 to, a county sheriff's office, a police department of a municipality 16 or city, or the state highway patrol; 17 3. "Media outlet" includes but is not limited to radio 18 19 stations, television stations, newspapers and local support 2 0 organizations; and 2 1 "Missing senior citizen or distressed individual" means a 22 person: 23 a. whose whereabouts are unknown,

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- b. whose age at the time the person is first reported
  missing is sixty (60) years of age or older and who is
  believed to be suffering from dementia or other
  cognitive impairment, and
  - c. whose disappearance poses a credible threat to the safety and health of the person, as determined by a local law enforcement agency, or
  - d. whose current mental health status prohibits them from reasonable and prudent judgment.
  - SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2011, Section 1-1990.3, is amended to read as follows:
  - Section 1-1990.3. The Department of Public Safety shall develop and implement a statewide silver alert system to be activated on behalf of a missing senior citizen or distressed individual in cooperation with the Department of Transportation, the Department of Human Services, any local law enforcement agency, the Oklahoma Association of Broadcasters and any other appropriate state or local agencies.
  - SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2011, Section 1-1990.4, is amended to read as follows:
  - Section 1-1990.4. The Commissioner of Public Safety is the statewide coordinator of the silver alert system and shall:
