6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to state property; requiring state  
8 agencies under certain conditions to provide fencing  
9 of property; defining term; exempting certain state  
10 properties; providing for codification; and providing  
11 an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 327.4 of Title 61, unless there  
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. For state property held by the state pursuant to Section 327  
17 of Title 61 of the Oklahoma Statutes, state agencies who have  
18 jurisdiction over parcels of land containing eighty (80) or more  
19 acres of contiguous land shall provide permanent fencing for the  
20 perimeter of the property. The agency shall provide the fencing and  
21 not the lessee.

22 For the purposes of this section, "permanent fencing" shall mean  
23 four wires with the three top wires being barbed with the bottom

wire not barbed. Any fence that is over one-quarter (1/4) of a mile in length shall have a wooden post every fifth post.

B. State-owned property pursuant to Section 2200 et seq. of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall be exempt from provisions of this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
