The agency shall provide the fencing and 21 not the lessee. 22 For the purposes of this section, "permanent fencing" shall mean 23 four wires with the three top wires being barbed with the bottom

2	in length shall have a wooden post every fifth post.
3	B. State-owned property pursuant to Section 2200 et seq. of
4	Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall be exempt from provisions of

6	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
