11	paragraph 14 of Section 5017 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
12	SECTION 2. This act shall not become effective unless Senate
13	Bill No. 72 of the 1st Session of the 55th Oklahoma Legislature
14	becomes effective as law.
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
