12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2011, Section 1210.192, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 1210.192. Any minor child, through the parent,
16	guardian, or legal custodian of the child, may submit to the health
17	authority charged with the enforcement of the immunization laws of
18	this state:
19	$\frac{1}{A}$ <u>a</u> certificate of a licensed physician as defined in
20	Section 725.2 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes, stating that the
21	physical condition of the child is such that immunization would
22	endanger the life or health of the child ; or
23	2. A written statement by the parent, guardian or legal
24	custodian of the child objecting to immunization of the child; ,

whereupon the child shall be exempt from the immunization laws of
this state.

3	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.
4	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
6	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
