2. "Race or sex scapegoating" means assigning fault, blame or bias to a race or sex, or to members of a race or sex because of his or her race or sex. It similarly encompasses any claim that, consciously or unconsciously, and by virtue of his or her race or sex, members of any race are inherently racist or are inherently inclined to oppress others, or that members of a sex are inherently sexist or inclined to oppress others.

Nothing in this section prevents agencies or departments of the this state from promoting racial, cultural or ethnic diversity or inclusiveness; provided, such efforts are consistent with the requirements of this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
