6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to counties and county officers;
8 amending 19 O.S. 2011, Section 1255, which relates to
9 road improvements; providing exception; preventing
10 the board of county commissioners from undertaking
11 projects on private property; prohibiting the board
12 of county commissioners from bidding against
13 commercial business; and providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2011, Section 1255, is
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 1255. ~~In~~ A. Except as otherwise provided in subsection
18 B of this section, in all cases where the board of county
19 commissioners shall deem it necessary to pave, construct, contract,
20 macadamize, chat or gravel, curb, gutter, drain or otherwise improve
21 any road, street, avenue, alley, lane or any part thereof, which
22 shall have been heretofore paved, constructed, macadamized, curbed,
23 guttered, drained or otherwise improved, such improvement is
24 authorized to be done under and in pursuance of the provisions of
25 this act, and in such case all provisions of this act for making

1 such improvements and levying assessments therefor and the issuance
2 of bonds shall apply.

3 B. The board of county commissioners is prohibited from paving,
4 constructing, contracting, macadamizing, applying chat or gravel,
5 curbing, guttering, draining or otherwise improving any road,
6 street, avenue, alley, lane or established surface of privately
7 owned property.

8 C. For any projects in the state, the board of county
9 commissioners is prohibited from bidding against commercial
10 businesses.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
