15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 36-122 of Title 11, unless there
18	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
19	Cities and towns are hereby authorized to adopt ordinances
20	enabling the painting of blue lines on city streets and the posting
21	of signage for the purpose of expressing support for law
22	enforcement.
23	The provisions of this section shall be considered an addition
24	to any federal or state law, rule or regulation regarding signage

1	requirements and roadway markings and shall not limit or amend any
2	other applicable laws, rules or regulations.
3	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
