11	temporary unclassified employees; authorizing certain state agencies to employ seasonal employees;

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16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-4d of Title 2, unless there is
19	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
20	A. For the purposes of the State Board of Agriculture, seasonal
21	employees employed by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food,
22	and Forestry who work less than nine hundred ninety-nine (999) hours
23	in a twelve-month period shall be considered temporary employees and
24	shall be unclassified.

1 The Department may employ seasonal employees throughout the в. 2 calendar year. Employees used for project labor employed by the Department for a period of time necessary to complete a project 3 shall be in the unclassified service of the state as provided by the 4 5 Oklahoma Personnel Act. Such employees shall not be entitled to paid leave, paid holidays, retirement, health, dental or life 6 7 insurance and shall be exempt from any laws, rules or practices providing for such benefits. 8

9 C. The Department, in its annual budget request, shall include 10 a summary of the use of project labor, which shall include the 11 number of workers employed under the provisions of this section and 12 the total wages paid to these employees.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-2-103a of Title 27A, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. For the purposes of the Oklahoma Conservation Commission, seasonal employees employed by the Commission who work less than nine hundred ninety-nine (999) hours in a twelve-month period shall be considered temporary employees and shall be unclassified.

B. The Commission may employ seasonal employees throughout the calendar year. Employees used for project labor employed by the Commission for a period of time necessary to complete a project shall be in the unclassified service of the state as provided by the Oklahoma Personnel Act. Such employees shall not be entitled to

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1 paid leave, paid holidays, retirement, health, dental or life 2 insurance and shall be exempt from any laws, rules or practices 3 providing for such benefits.

C. The Commission, in its annual budget request, shall include
a summary of the use of project labor, which shall include the
number of workers employed under the provisions of this section and
the total wages paid to these employees.

8 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 9 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1085.2A of Title 82, unless 10 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. For the purposes of the Oklahoma Water Resources Board, seasonal employees employed by the Board who work less than nine hundred ninety-nine (999) hours in a twelve-month period shall be considered temporary employees and shall be unclassified.

The Board may employ seasonal employees throughout the 15 в. calendar year. Employees used for project labor employed by the 16 17 Board for a period of time necessary to complete a project shall be in the unclassified service of the state as provided by the Oklahoma 18 Personnel Act. Such employees shall not be entitled to paid leave, 19 paid holidays, retirement, health, dental or life insurance and 20 shall be exempt from any laws, rules or practices providing for such 21 benefits. 22

C. The Board, in its annual budget request, shall include asummary of the use of project labor, which shall include the number

2	total wages paid to these employees.
3	SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
4	of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
5	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
6	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
