Providing any disposition, service, financial aid or benefit 16 to an individual which is different, or is provided in a different 17 manner, from that provided to other members of the general public; 18 2. Subjecting any individual to segregation or separate 19 treatment in any matter related to that individual's receipt of any 20 disposition, service, financial aid or benefit provided to other 21 members of the general public; 22 3. Restricting an individual in any way in the enjoyment of any 23

advantage or privilege enjoyed by others receiving any disposition,

Treating an individual differently from others in determining whether that individual satisfies any admission, enrollment, quota, eligibility, membership or other requirement or condition which individuals must meet in order to be provided any disposition, service, financial aid, function or benefit available to other members of the general public; or
- 5. Denying an individual an opportunity to participate in a program through the provision of service or otherwise afford that individual an opportunity to do so which is different from that afforded to other members of the general public.
- SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
