17	hereby authorized to lease space within:
18	1. Within the State Office Building in Tulsa, Oklahoma, to
19	private persons; or
20	2. Where the Director of the Department of Human Services or
21	the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services has
22	identified an appropriate location for lease to a third party to
23	provide for the limited purpose of implementing Sections 4190
24	through 4192 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
