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19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:			
20	SECTION 1. The Department of Transportation shall expend from			
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	the funds dedicated to construction up to Dollars			
22	(\$0.00) for the construction of roads to existing industrial sites			
23	and roads for economic development purposes, and up to			
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Dollars (\$0.00) for the construction, maintenance and repair of roads to historical sites and lake access roads.

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SECTION 2. The Director of the Office of TRANSFER Management and Enterprise Services shall transfer the sum of One Million Nine Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,900,000.00) from the State Highway Construction and Maintenance Fund to the Public Transit Revolving Fund of the State Treasury. These funds shall be expended in the same manner and for the same purposes as provided by law for other monies accruing to the credit of the Public Transit Revolving Fund.

SECTION 3. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, the Department of Transportation shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

SECTION 5. The Department of Transportation is hereby authorized to use any funds available to the Department to match funds which are advanced under the provisions of Sections 402, 403 and 419, Public Law 93-288, Disaster Relief Act of 1974, to repair, restore, reconstruct or replace public transportation facilities or to remove debris or wreckage from publicly owned facilities. The Department of Transportation shall coordinate with the Oklahoma Department of Emergency Management for expenditure of funds for such purpose.

SECTION 6. All funds available by law for expenditure by the Department of Transportation may be used and expended in conjunction or cooperation with any federal agency or instrumentality pursuant to such terms and conditions as may be necessary to obtain grants or federal aid assistance in accordance with state law.

SECTION 7. Appropriations made by this act, not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016 (hereafter FY-16), or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017 (hereafter FY-17). Funds budgeted for FY-16 may be encumbered only through June 30,

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    2016, and must be expended by November 15, 2016. Any funds
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    remaining after November 15, 2016, and not budgeted for FY-17, shall
    lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
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    year. Funds budgeted for FY-16 may be encumbered only through June
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    30, 2017. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2017, shall lapse
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    to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
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    These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
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    simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-16, and not required to pay
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    obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-17, after
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    the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
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    and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
    from the FY-16 budget work program and after such revision has been
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    approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
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        SECTION 8. This act shall become effective September 1, 2015.
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
