## An Act

ENROLLED SENATE BILL NO. 841

An Act relating to public finance; amending Section 1 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 17 and Section 3 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 749 of the 1st Session of the 56th Oklahoma Legislature, which relate to revolving funds; clarifying monies to be deposited to certain revolving funds; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

SUBJECT: Revolving fund functions

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 17 of the 1st Session of the 56th Oklahoma Legislature is amended to read as follows:

A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund for the Oklahoma Historical Society to be designated the "1921 Tulsa Race Riot Centennial Memorial Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the Oklahoma Historical Society from appropriations, donations or any other source and designated for the purpose set forth in this section. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma Historical Society for the purpose of commemoration of the centennial of the 1921 Tulsa Race

Riot. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

B. Any funds in the revolving fund created in Section 8201.2 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes on the effective date of this act shall be transferred to the 1921 Tulsa Race Riot Centennial Memorial Revolving Fund.

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY Section 3 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 749 of the 1st Session of the 56th Oklahoma Legislature is amended to read as follows:

There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund for the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry to be designated the "Urban Gardens Grant Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the State Board of Agriculture from state-appropriated funds, federal funds, donations, grants and contributions from any public or private source and designated for the purpose set forth in this section. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry for the purpose of administering the Urban Gardens Grant Act. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
