

1 U.S.C., Section 214(e) (6) for any portion of Oklahoma, hereinafter
2 referred to as "private providers", shall submit to the Oklahoma
3 Broadband Office a copy of the ~~broadband network area coverage map~~
4 data the private providers ~~are required to~~ submit to the FCC
5 pursuant to the federal Broadband Deployment Accuracy and
6 Technological Availability Act, 47 U.S.C., Section 641 et seq. The
7 map data shall be updated annually through a supplemental submission
8 by the private providers ~~that reflects changes in area coverage from~~
9 ~~the preceding year, including~~ and any updates ~~that are the result of~~
10 relating to incentives and grants created, administered, or awarded
11 by the Office. The Office is authorized to promulgate rules for the
12 collection of the broadband network area coverage map reports from
13 the private providers.

14 B. On or before October 31 of each year, OneNet, the Office of
15 Management and Enterprise Services, the Oklahoma Corporation
16 Commission, and the Oklahoma Department of Transportation,
17 hereinafter referred to as "public entities", shall submit to the
18 Office and the Broadband Expansion Council broadband network area
19 coverage map data of all assets and network coverage in the format
20 requested by the Office.

21 C. Private providers and public entities shall disclose to the
22 Office the properties they serve and the maximum advertised download
23 and upload speeds at which they provide any Internet services to
24 those properties.

1 D. The reports and information required to be disclosed
2 pursuant to this section by private providers shall remain
3 confidential pursuant to Section 24A.10 of Title 51 of the Oklahoma
4 Statutes. The Office shall determine the required submission format
5 of the data submitted under the provisions of this act.

6 E. On or before December 1 of each year, the Office shall
7 update the statewide broadband services map required by subsection E
8 of Section 5 of this act using the data collected under the
9 provisions of this act in a manner that identifies the assets and
10 service areas of the public entities while displaying anonymized
11 information, without reference to any specific private provider, of
12 the assets and service areas of private providers.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.

14 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
15 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
16 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
17 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
