16	Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no state entity or
17	political subdivision of this state shall deny government services
18	or entrance into government buildings to any person based solely on:
19	1. The wearing of a mask or face covering; or
20	2. The vaccination or immunity status of the person.
21	As used in this section, "political subdivision" means a county,
22	city, town, school district or other local governmental or public
23	entity located within this state.
