6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to medical marijuana; directing
8 Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs
9 Control to implement certain program; directing
10 certain licensees to utilize certain entity;
11 authorizing acceptance of marijuana; specifying
12 certain disposal methods; directing promulgation of
13 rules; providing for codification; and providing an
14 effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-112 of Title 63, unless there
18 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. The Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control
20 shall develop and implement a program for the disposal of medical
21 marijuana waste.

22 B. All state licensed dispensaries, growers, processors and
23 testing laboratories shall utilize a disposal entity licensed by the
24 Bureau who is hereby authorized to accept marijuana, marijuana
25 products and other forms of marijuana waste for purposes of disposal
26 from patients, caregivers, dispensaries, growers, processors and

1 researchers licensed pursuant to Section 420 et seq. of Title 63 of
2 the Oklahoma Statutes.

3 C. Methods utilized in the disposal program shall include, but
4 not be limited to:

- 5 1. Destruction of marijuana waste;
- 6 2. Rendering marijuana waste unusable; and
- 7 3. Recycling marijuana waste for use as compost.

8 D. The Commission of the Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics and
9 Dangerous Drugs Control shall promulgate such rules as are necessary
10 to implement the provisions of this section.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.

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
