9	providing automatic moratorium on certain funding depending on certain certification of revenue;

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13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 9030.5, as
15	amended by Section 5, Chapter 196, O.S.L. 2015 (74 O.S. Supp. 2017,
16	Section 9030.5), is amended to read as follows:
17	Section 9030.5. A. 1. Except as otherwise provided by
18	subsection C of this section, all state agencies, including
19	institutions within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education,
20	all state departments, boards, councils, and commissions shall
21	allocate, as a nondeductible item out of any expenditures for
22	capital projects including, but not limited to, bond issues for
23	state construction excluding costs for bond issuance and related
24	reserves, an amount of one and one-half percent (1 $1/2$ %) of the

expenditure to the Oklahoma Arts Council for the purpose of funding
 the Oklahoma Art in Public Places Act, except as otherwise provided
 by subsection B of this section.

2. The maximum assessment for any project shall not exceed Five 4 5 Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00). This assessment shall not apply to any private donations for a capital project. This 6 7 allocation shall be applicable to all state agency capital projects approved by the appointing authority after September 1, 2004. 8 The 9 works of art commissioned pursuant to the Oklahoma Art in Public 10 Places Act may be placed on public lands, integral to or attached to 11 a public building or structure, or detached within or outside a 12 public building or structure.

1. Of the assessment provided for in subsection A of this 13 Β. section, four-fifths (4/5) shall be placed in the Commissioning of 14 Art in Public Places Revolving Fund, created in Section 9030.6 of 15 this title, for the commission of any work of art for the Oklahoma 16 17 Art in Public Places Act. Institutions within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education shall remain in complete administrative 18 control of their four-fifths (4/5) assessment pursuant to this 19 subsection for the acquisition of art. The remaining one-fifth 20 (1/5) of the assessment shall be reserved for the Art in Public 21 Places Administrative and Maintenance Revolving Fund created by 22 Section 9030.7 of this title. 23

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2. Monies deposited in the Art in Public Places Administrative
 and Maintenance Revolving Fund for the purpose of this moratorium,
 shall be used for continued administration, educational costs, and
 maintenance.

5 C. The provisions of subsection A of this section shall not be
6 applicable for the fiscal years ending:

7 1. June 30, 2012;

8 2. June 30, 2013; and

9 3. June 30, 2014 any fiscal year in which the revenue 10 certification approved by the State Board of Equalization at the 11 February meeting of the Board is less than the amount certified by 12 the Board at the February meeting of the previous year. 13 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby 14 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and 15 be in full force from and after its passage and approval. 16

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
