13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3106.5 of Title 74, unless there
15	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	A. The Legislature, seeking to protect against the overreach of
17	governmental entities and to safeguard the individual freedoms of
18	taxpayers and businesses, intends to preempt any other ordinance
19	enacted or adopted to mandate the wearing of masks on public and
20	private property.
21	B. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, cities and towns
22	of this state may neither enact nor enforce any ordinance or other
23	local law conflicting with subsection A of this section.

2	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
3	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
4	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
