1 cents (\$0.016) for each gallon of ethyl alcohol which is contained 2 in ethanol sold by a retail dealer before November 1, 2018. 3 C. Notwithstanding any other provision of the Oklahoma Motor Fuel Tax Code to the contrary, the retail dealer described by 4 5 subsection A of this section may make the claim for refund from the Oklahoma Tax Commission. The refund claim process for the credit 6 7 authorized by this section shall be substantially the same as the refund claims process authorized by the Motor Fuel Tax Code for 9 other refunds provided by law. 10 D. Each claim for refund filed pursuant to this section shall 11 be accompanied by such documentation as may be required by the Tax 12 Commission that the retail dealer reduced the retail price for each gallon of ethyl alcohol which is contained in ethanol sold, and for 13 which the credit authorized by this section is claimed, by one and 14 six-tenths cents (\$0.016) and that such cost savings was 15 economically provided to the purchaser of the ethanol fuel. 16 SECTION 2.
