An Act relating to law enforcement training; amending Section 3, Chapter 376, O.S.L. 2016 (70 O.S. Supp. 2016, Section 3311.15), which relates to the assessment for meals; modifying certain fee; and providing an effective date.

SUBJECT: Law enforcement training

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 3, Chapter 376, O.S.L. 2016 (70 O.S. Supp. 2016, Section 3311.15), is amended to read as follows:

Section 3311.15. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training (CLEET) is hereby authorized to assess a ~~charge~~ registration fee not to exceed ~~Twenty Dollars (\$20.00)~~ Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) per day to any Oklahoma Law Enforcement Agency ~~for payment of breakfast and lunch expenses, incurred~~ to cover the costs of breakfast, lunch and dinner meals provided by CLEET, during the training of agency peace officers. Failure to timely pay these charges will preclude future participation of any employee of the law enforcement agency in the CLEET Basic Academy. All moneys from charges assessed for these purposes shall be deposited in the Peace Officer Revolving Fund created in Section 3311.7 of ~~Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes~~ this title.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
