11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
12	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 11-314, as
13	amended by Section 1, Chapter 114, O.S.L. 2015 (47 O.S. Supp. 2018,
14	Section 11-314), is amended to read as follows:
15	Section 11-314. A. The driver of a motor vehicle, upon
16	approaching a stationary authorized emergency vehicle, a Department
17	of Transportation maintenance vehicle, a Turnpike Authority
18	maintenance vehicle, or a licensed Class AA wrecker that is
19	displaying a flashing combination red or blue light or any
20	combination of red or blue lights, shall:
21	1. If traveling on a highway that consists of two or more lanes
22	that carry traffic in the same direction of travel as that of the
23	driver, the driver shall proceed with due caution and shall, if
24	possible and with due regard to the road, weather, and traffic

- conditions, change lanes into a lane that is not adjacent to the
 stationary authorized emergency vehicle, a Department of
 Transportation maintenance vehicle, a Turnpike Authority maintenance
 vehicle, or licensed Class AA wrecker; or if the driver is not able
 to change lanes or if to do so would be unsafe, the driver shall
 proceed with due caution and reduce the speed of the motor vehicle
 to a safe speed for the existing road, weather, and traffic
 conditions; and
 - 2. If traveling on a highway other than a highway described in paragraph 1 of this subsection, the driver shall proceed with due caution and reduce the speed of the motor vehicle to a safe speed for the existing road, weather, and traffic conditions.
 - B. This section does not relieve the operator of a stationary authorized emergency vehicle, a Department of Transportation maintenance vehicle, a Turnpike Authority maintenance vehicle, or licensed Class AA wrecker from the consequences of reckless disregard for the safety of all persons and property upon the highway.
- C. A driver of a motor vehicle, upon approaching a stationary
 vehicle that is displaying flashing lights, shall proceed with due
 caution and shall, if possible and with due regard to the road,
 weather, and traffic conditions, change lanes into a lane that is
 not adjacent to the stationary vehicle; or if the driver is not able
 to change lanes or if to do so would be unsafe, the driver shall
