10 An Act relating to the Health Care Workforce Training
11 Commission and the State Board of Career and
12 Technology Education; making appropriations; stating
13 purposes; authorizing certain expenditures; requiring
14 rules and procedures to be established; providing an
15 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Health Care
18 Workforce Development Revolving Fund, created in Enrolled House Bill
19 No. 2776 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, from
20 any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Statewide Recovery
21 Fund of the State Treasury created in Enrolled House Bill No. 3349
22 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One
23 Million Six Hundred Forty Thousand Six Hundred Thirty Dollars
24 (\$1,640,630.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to establish
a grant program with Indian Capital Technology Center for the

1 purpose of recruiting, educating, and stabilizing Oklahoma's health
2 care workforce. Such funding shall be used as recommended and
3 approved by the Joint Committee on Pandemic Relief Funding on June
4 7, 2022.

5 SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Health Care
6 Workforce Development Revolving Fund, created in Enrolled House Bill
7 No. 2776 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, from
8 any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Statewide Recovery
9 Fund of the State Treasury created in Enrolled House Bill No. 3349
10 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Two
11 Million Thirty-two Thousand Seven Hundred Sixty-seven Dollars
12 (\$2,032,767.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to establish
13 a grant program with Metro Technology Centers for the purpose of
14 recruiting, educating, and stabilizing Oklahoma's health care
15 workforce. Such funding shall be used as recommended and approved
16 by the Joint Committee on Pandemic Relief Funding on June 7, 2022.

17 SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Health Care
18 Workforce Development Revolving Fund, created in Enrolled House Bill
19 No. 2776 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, from
20 any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Statewide Recovery
21 Fund of the State Treasury created in Enrolled House Bill No. 3349
22 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One
23 Million Six Hundred Twenty-five Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty-eight
24 Dollars (\$1,625,858.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to

1 establish a grant program with Tri County Tech for the purpose of
2 recruiting, educating, and stabilizing Oklahoma's health care
3 workforce. Such funding shall be used as recommended and approved
4 by the Joint Committee on Pandemic Relief Funding on June 7, 2022.

5 SECTION 4. There is hereby appropriated to the Health Care
6 Workforce Development Revolving Fund, created in Enrolled House Bill
7 No. 2776 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, from
8 any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Statewide Recovery
9 Fund of the State Treasury created in Enrolled House Bill No. 3349
10 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of
11 Three Million Five Hundred Four Thousand Three Hundred Sixty-eight
12 Dollars (\$3,504,368.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to
13 establish a grant program with the State Board of Career and
14 Technology Education for the purpose of recruiting, educating, and
15 stabilizing Oklahoma's health care workforce. Such funding shall be
16 used as recommended and approved by the Joint Committee on Pandemic
17 Relief Funding on June 7, 2022.

18 SECTION 5. The Health Care Workforce Training Commission shall
19 promulgate rules and establish procedures for evaluating and
20 awarding grant applications for the grant programs provided for in
21 this act.

22 SECTION 6. The State Board of Career and Technology Education
23 shall promulgate rules and establish procedures for evaluating and
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1 awarding grant applications for the grant programs provided for in
2 this act.

3 SECTION 7. This act shall become effective September 1, 2022.

4 SECTION 8. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
6 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
