12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1272, as
14	last amended by Section 1, Chapter 102, O.S.L. 2013 (21 O.S. Supp.
15	2014, Section 1272), is amended to read as follows:
16	Section 1272.
17	UNLAWFUL CARRY
18	A. It shall be unlawful for any person to carry upon or about
19	his or her person, or in a purse or other container belonging to the
20	person, any pistol, revolver, shotgun or rifle whether loaded or
21	unloaded or any dagger, bowie knife, dirk knife, switchblade knife,
22	sword cane, knife having a blade which opens automatically by hand
23	pressure applied to a button, spring, or other device in the handle
24	of the knife, blackjack, loaded cane, billy, hand chain, metal

knuckles, or any other offensive weapon, whether such weapon be
 concealed or unconcealed, except this section shall not prohibit:

3 1. The proper use of guns and knives for hunting, fishing,4 educational or recreational purposes;

5 2. The carrying or use of weapons in a manner otherwise
6 permitted by statute or authorized by the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act;

3. The carrying, possession and use of any weapon by a peace
officer or other person authorized by law to carry a weapon in the
performance of official duties and in compliance with the rules of
the employing agency;

11 4. The carrying or use of weapons in a courthouse by a district 12 judge, associate district judge or special district judge within 13 this state, who is in possession of a valid handgun license issued 14 pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act and 15 whose name appears on a list maintained by the Administrative 16 Director of the Courts; or

5. The carrying and use of firearms and other weapons provided 17 in this subsection when used for the purpose of living history 18 reenactment. For purposes of this paragraph, "living history 19 reenactment" means depiction of historical characters, scenes, 20 historical life or events for entertainment, education, or 21 historical documentation through the wearing or use of period, 22 historical, antique or vintage clothing, accessories, firearms, 23 weapons, and other implements of the historical period. 24
