6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to dogs; requiring physical restraint
8 of dogs within a city or town; making it a
9 misdemeanor for violations of this act; providing a
fine; providing for codification; and providing an
effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 42.5 of Title 4, unless there is
14 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 A. Within any city or town, an owner of a dog shall not permit
16 the dog to be outside of a private enclosure or an enclosed public
17 dog park unless the dog is restrained by a substantial chain or
18 leash and under the physical restraint of a responsible person.

19 B. Any violator of subsection A of this section, upon
20 conviction, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of
21 not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
