16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7-207 of Title 70, unless there
18	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
19	A. The administrative services of an independent or dependent
20	school district that had an average daily membership of less than
21	two hundred (200) during the 2017-2018 school year, shall be
22	combined with a contiguous school district or districts pursuant to
23	the provisions of this section.

B. 1. By September 1, 2018, the State Board of Education shall 1 notify school districts that meet the criteria established in 2 subsection A of this section. The State Board of Education shall 3 take action necessary to assist school districts that meet the 4 5 criteria established in subsection A of this section to reach an agreement on combining the administrative services of the school 6 7 district with one or more contiguous school districts. If any school districts cannot reach an agreement by June 30, 2019, the 8 9 Board shall formulate an agreement between the districts outlining how the administrative services will be shared and how the costs 10 will be allocated. 11

The combining of administrative services of school districts
 required by paragraph 1 of this subsection shall be complete
 effective July 1, 2020.

15 C. Any agreement for sharing administrative services shall 16 address the division of the following:

17 1. Time of each employee;

18 2. Payment of benefits of each employee;

Contributions to the Teachers' Retirement System of Oklahoma
 for each employee;

4. How each employee will be counted for calculating certain
weights for purposes of the State Aid Formula as provided for in
Section 18-201.1 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and

5. Payment of any employees who are employed on a continuing
 multi-year contract at the time administrative services are
 combined.

D. School districts which meet the criteria established in
subsection A of this section and enter into a mutual contract with a
superintendent as authorized pursuant to Section 5-106A of Title 70
of the Oklahoma Statutes shall be authorized to receive funds from
the School Consolidation Assistance Fund as provided for in Section
7-203 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

10 For the purposes of this section, "administrative services" Ε. 11 shall mean the duties of any employee of a school district employed 12 as a superintendent, assistant superintendent, director, coordinator or supervisor and the duties of any employee who has responsibility 13 for administrative functions of a school district, including but not 14 limited to human resources, purchasing, accounting and information 15 technology. "Administrative services" shall not mean the duties of 16 principals or assistant principals. 17

F. The Board shall promulgate rules necessary to implement theprovisions of this section.

20 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2018. 21 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 22 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby 23
