6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to hunting and fishing; requiring the
8 Wildlife Conservation Commission to create a special
9 use permit; providing land size restriction;
10 providing terms of permit; exempting certain license
11 requirements; stating price restriction for permit;
12 providing for codification; and providing an
13 effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4-113.2 of Title 29, unless
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. The Wildlife Conservation Commission shall establish a
19 three-day and five-day special use permit to be purchased by a
20 landowner for a tract of land that is two hundred (200) acres or
21 more.

22 B. The special use permit shall allow residents and
23 nonresidents with the permission of the landowner to hunt and fish
24 on the tract of land, and the individuals shall be exempt from
25

1 hunting and fishing license requirements for the term that the
2 special use permit is issued.

3 C. The term for the special use permit shall only be for
4 consecutive days.

5 D. The price of the special use permit shall not exceed Five
6 Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
